Kindergarten/Jr. Kindergarten Tours-



This year we will not be able to hold an Open House for visiting Jr. Kdgn./ Kindergarten (or Pre-School) classrooms. However, Miss Karen will be offering evening tours beginning at either 5:30 pm. or 6:00pm. (Tours will run about a half hour.) We are asking that you speak to Miss Karen or reach office to the (847.825.3767)to arrange a date and time for your tour. Children who will have turned 5 years-old by September 1, 2022 will be eligible for the

2022-23 Kindergarten class. (Children with July, August, September, and October, birthdays would be age appropriate for our Junior Kindergarten.)
Our Kindergarten/Jr. Kindergarten class will be

held 5 days/week from 9-12:00pm, with a full day option including lunch and afternoon enrichment program. Children picked up at 1:30pm do not have a rest period. Full day child care services are, of course, also available (6:30am-5:30pm).

The parents of our students have enjoyed the small group attention for their children, the extended hours, the well-rounded curriculum, which includes Christian Education and the special care and concern provided by Miss Terri, Miss Rose and the rest of the child care staff.

Materials for Messiah's summer (2022) and fall (2022-2023) registration will be placed in the folders of each currently enrolled Messiah child during the week of January 24th (earlier if possible). We will guarantee a position for all applications returned with the registration fees and deposits by Monday, February 14th. (depending on whether or not classes fill up with the registrations received before yours, it may not be the position you request) Whereas we will try to honor schedule, classroom and classmate requests as much as class space allows, it is impossible for us to quarantee everything to everyone. Requests for specific teachers cannot be guaranteed as staffing and teacher assignments confirmed until the Registrations received after February 14th will be added to the 'outside' applications and will be processed, on a first come basis, to fill any stillavailable positions after 'in-house' registration.

Planning for Fall 2022-2023-School visits for new and returning families

Since we will not be able to host our all school Open House in February due to the Covid restrictions, we will be scheduling evening visits with Miss Karen, Monday through Thursday at either 5:30pm or 6:00pm. Outdoor Winter Clothing

A reminder that we do **try** to go outdoors to play or to take a walk during the winter months. On snowy and/or cold days, please, send a hat, mittens (water proof), scarf, snow pants (or a snow suit), boots, etc. To aid in identification, please, label as many articles of clothing as possible, with your child's name and remind your child which articles of clothing belong to him/her since he/she may not be familiar with new clothes.

Please be sure your child's clothes fit well enough to keep out the snow and cold and be sure that he/she has a change of clothing (especially pants and long sleeved shirt) as well as indoor shoes (see information below). Thanks!

School Shoes

Please send a pair of shoes that can stay at school, for indoor activities, until the snow season is over. Shoes should be non-lace shoes that your child can easily put on and take off independently. Your child should then wear winter boots to school each day that will be used for outdoor play and for commuting back home at the end of each school day.
